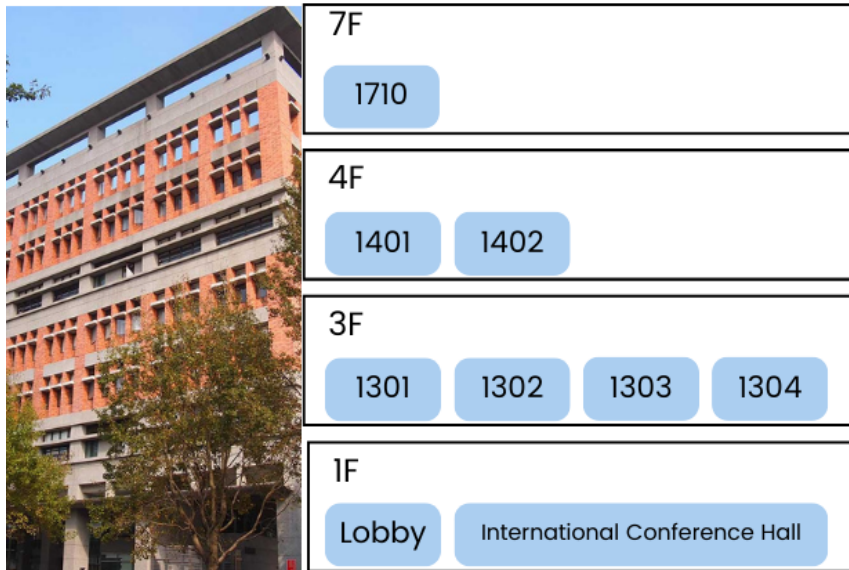

Airport Transportation to Taipei

- From Taoyuan Airport

Airport MRT  (Recommended)	~35-40 min	NT\$160 (≈US\$5)	Every 15 min	Take the Airport MRT (Express or Commuter Train) from Taoyuan Airport Station to Taipei Main Station
Taxi 	~40-50 min	NT\$1,000-1,200 (≈US\$32-US\$38)	On demand	Take a taxi from the airport taxi stand directly to Taipei Main Station
Airport Bus 1819  (Kuo-Kuang Line)	~50-60 min	NT\$164 (≈US\$5)	Every 15-30 min	Board at Bus Station → Get off at Taipei Main Station
Taiwan High-Speed Rail (THSR)	~40-50 min	NT\$185 (≈US\$6) (MRT + THSR)	Every 10-15 min	1. Take Airport MRT to THSR Taoyuan Station (15 min, NT\$25) → 2. Transfer to THSR train to Taipei Main Station (20 min, NT\$160)

- From Taipei Songshan Airport:

Songshan Airport is located in Taipei. You can take a short ride by taxi or Uber (approx. within 15 mins) or **MRT or Taipei Bus to the venue or your hotel.**

City Transportation to the Venue

National Taiwan University is located right in the center of Taipei city and can be easily accessed by MRT, Taxi, Uber, or Taipei bus.

- By MRT: you may take Wenhua Line (Brown Line) to Technology Building Station and take a 10-minute walk along FuXing S. Road to FuXing-XinHai intersection, where the XinHai Gate is. The Tsai Lecture Hall will be on the left-hand side of the Gate. You may also take the Songshan-Xindian Line (Green Line) to GongGuan Station for a 15-minute walk across the campus.

- By Taxi or Uber

Taxis and Uber rides are widely available in Taipei City and provide a convenient way to reach the venue. Hotels usually offer taxi reservation services. Simply provide the driver with the address: Tsai Lecture Hall, College of Law, National Taiwan University, No.1, Section 4, Roosevelt Rd., Taipei. Mention the XinHai Gate at the intersection of Xinhai Rd. and Fuxing S. Rd. as a reference point.

- By Bus

You may also arrive at the College of Law by buses at HePing Senior High School, Youth Activity Center, Fuxing South Road Intersection, and Gongguan Station.

Visa

Foreign nationals must obtain visas to enter Taiwan. They should hold foreign passports or travel documents valid for more than six months. You may have different visa requirements to enter Taiwan depending on your nationality.
